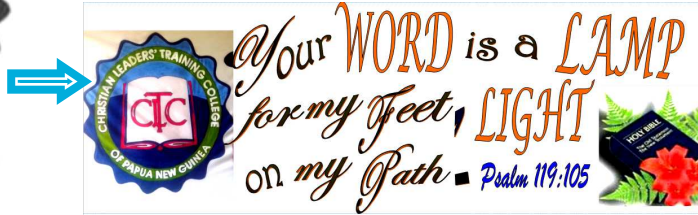

Discipleship, a Life of Dependence

...If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples (John 8:31b NIV)

In some translations the term *hold* in the NIV is translated as *continue* or even *abide*. These terms signify an intentional act of dependence on another. In this case, Jesus' words are loud and clear, there is no other way of becoming a disciple, except in holding on to or continuing to or by abiding to Jesus and his teaching.

In the verses (especially 26*But he who send me is reliable, and what I heard from Him I tell the world* and 28 – 29 *I do nothing on my own but speak just what the Father has taught me. The One who sent me is with me; he has not left me alone, for I always do what pleases him*) before Jesus' instructions on the importance of dependence in relation to discipleship, Jesus himself provided the example of dependence. This profound exemplary dependence portrays the origin and destiny of being a true disciple of Jesus Christ.

In the verses that follows (especially 32 ... *you will know the truth...truth will set you free*) Jesus relates discipleship to knowing the truth and the truth setting free those who know and hold unswervingly to the truth, meaning nothing to do with falsehood (vs.34). This means 'knowing' and 'freeing' are compatible in discipleship. The Truth in the person of Jesus, not just in our perception of intellectual purity, but being made free from falsehood following Jesus as his disciples as we walk in the light of his word. By continuing in his word we will know the truth – not so much about greater doctrinal knowledge about Jesus, but our life-
